

Compliance to AS9100, ISO 9001 or AC7004 Quality System unless waiver on file,

Calibration labs must be certified to the latest edition of ISO 17025, ANSI/NCSL Z540.1 or ISO 10012,

Notify AFI of nonconforming product; obtain AFI approval for nonconforming product disposition,
Notify AFI of changes in product and/or process definition, changes of suppliers, change of manufacturing facility location and, where required, obtain AFI approval,

Flow down to the supply chain the applicable requirements including customer requirements,

Aircraft Fasteners policy is not to export ITAR controlled defense articles. To ensure proper classification, suppliers are required to identify ITAR controlled product at the time of quote and/or order acceptance.

Maintain adequate records of all inspections and tests. Records shall be kept for a period of ten (10) years after final payment for supplies or services,

Provide right of access to AFI, their customer and regulatory authorities to the applicable areas of all facilities, at any level of the supply chain, involved in the order and to all applicable records,

Provide certificate of conformity, test reports and/or airworthiness certificate,

Provide Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) and/or certificates of compliances for restricted, toxic or hazardous substances,

Material suppliers must furnish material certifications with original mill certifications in English to the purchase order requirements, and shall not supply material for which they are not certified or approved.

Any delay in shipment must be conveyed to AFI Purchasing as soon as the delay is known.

Any changes to the contract requirements by the supplier must be approved by AFI in writing.

Additional quality clauses will be noted on the Purchase Order as required.
